

Minutes of the PG Admission Committee meeting held on 24th May, 2019.

A meeting on PG admission was held on 24th May, 2019 at 2.00 pm in the Conference Hall of Administrative Block, Bodoland University under the chairmanship of Prof. P.K. Patra to discuss about the PG admission for the session 2019-21. The meeting was convened by Academic Registrar i/c, Bodoland University. The House discussed on various agenda and adopted the following resolutions:

Resolution No. 1: The eligibility criteria to apply for PG course would be 50% in graduation course for honours students. However, 5% relaxation would be given to ST/SC candidates.

Resolution No. 2: Only honours students would be able to apply for PG course except MCA course.

Resolution No. 3: The eligibility criteria for applying in MCA course would be 50% for honours students and 55% for general students.

Resolution No. 4: The reservation quota would not be filled by other candidates in case of shortage of candidates at reservation quota.

Resolution No. 5: Language lab fees of Rs 1100/- would be included in English, Assamese and Bodo subjects.

Resolution No. 6: Laboratory for Mathematical Sciences would be made and laboratory fees would be made Rs 8000/- instead of Rs 1100/-.

Resolution No. 7: Seat capacity for Geography department would be finalized by Hon'ble VC.

Resolution No. 8: Seat capacity of MCA would be reduced to 30 from 60. *After discussion the intake seat capacity is decided not to change.*

Resolution No. 9: Same fees would be adapted for MCA as per Computer Science.

Resolution No. 10: Magazine Fees would be reduced from Rs 330/- to Rs 200/-.

Resolution No. 11: Following fees would be included in admission under Students Welfare Fund (Rs 400/-)-

- i. National Unity Day fee - Rs 10/-
- ii. Saraswati Puja fee- Rs 20/-
- iii. Students General Facility- Rs 200/-
- iv. Swaach Bharat fee- Rs 30/-
- v. Mahatma Gandhi Birthday- Rs 10/-
- vi. World Environment Day- Rs 10/-
- vii. International Yoga Day- Rs 10/-
- viii. Youth Festival – Rs 100/-
- ix. International Mother Language Day- Rs 10/-
